PreK – Grade 1

July 6 – July 10 (Week 1) – My World

In drawings, collages and paintings, children will explore family, home, and the concept of community. Journey with us as we explore and re-create everyday life and culture both near and far.

July 13 – 17 (Week 2) – In the Wild

We will explore animals of the forests, jungles and our own backyard creating animals and their habitats using paint, mixed media and clay.

July 20– 24 (Week 3) – Tell Me a Story

Fairy tales, imaginary kingdoms, Dr. Seuss and many other stories will come to life as your little ones create their own imaginative stories using pencil, paper, and paints to create drawings, collages and puppets.

July 27 – July 31 (Week 4) – Rhythm, Rhyme and Me

We'll shake it up with songs, percussion instruments, and artwork that makes you want to dance. Using bold designs in paints, collage and 3-D sculptures, we will attempt to capture the excitement of music in our artwork.

Grades 2 – 5

July 6 – July 10 (Week 1) – Cartooning and Illustration

Using drawing skills, students will express their thoughts and feelings in story form as they learn and expand basic concepts in drawing action figures, animals, and self styled characters.

July 13 – 17 (Week 2) – Art Safari

Traveling through space, time and imagination, we will develop skills in drawing dinosaurs, other prehistoric animals, and creatures of lands both real and imagined.

July 20– 24 (Week 3) – Heads and Tales

Roll up your sleeves and collect your thoughts. We will be designing background scenery, face sculptures, and puppet heads to go along with our stories and imaginary tales. Pencil, paint, clay, collage and papier-mache will all be used.

July 27 – 31 (Week 4) – Rhythm and Design-Art of the Drum


We will discover the connections between art and music in paintings. We will study the designs on drums and other instruments, with opportunity to learn basic music skills.
